All flights, accommodation and transportation will be arranged by Overlake. You can expect to stay in dorm type housing (with showers and flushing toilets). The food will either be prepared by some of our local friends or eaten in restaurants.

PREPARATION

We recognize that participating in a trip like this can feel intimidating, however we are committed to help equip you for this experience. You don't need any special qualifications, just a willingness to show up and be used by God. However, in order for you to get the most out of your experience, there are some requests we do ask of you.

Training Meetings: Please attend all pre-trip training meetings (approx. six). These are vitally important to your personal preparation, as well as that of the team!

Prayer Team: Please build a prayer team of around 5-7 people who will commit to praying for you and the team throughout your experience.

Financial Team: Please invite friends and family to partner with you financially. This is an opportunity for others to be involved in the mission as well. We will equip you with resources on how to do this.

Open Heart: Please approach this experience with a posture of humility and an open heart. We have so much to learn from our hosts as well as what God wants to do personally in each of our lives. Keep in mind, the most important thing may not be the trip itself, but how God wants you to live as a *result* of your experience.
