Overlake has been partnering for years with a phenomenal Kenyan run organization, Agape Children's Ministry, which has rescued thousands of children living on streets and successfully reintegrated them back into loving families. Agape is working in 3 different cities in Kenya, offering comprehensive social services to children and families through their rehabilitation centers. Every year Overlake sends a team to come alongside the ministry there, to encourage the workers, and love on children both living at the centers and on the streets. This trip is an incredible opportunity that will ruin you in all the right ways!

Activities you can expect to participate in...

Children's Programing - This would include helping to facilitate songs, crafts, bible stories, games and small group time for children at the center in two of the locations.

Street Outreach - This would include assisting local staff in their daily visits to the streets, building relationships with children and pointing them to opportunities available to them at the center.

What you can expect logistically...

All flights, accommodation and transportation will be arranged by Overlake. You can expect to stay in guest houses or modest hotels (with showers and flushing toilets). The food will either be prepared by some of our local friends or eaten in restaurants.

- Grow our hearts for the nations
- Build deeper relationship with our global partners & our understanding of their ministry
- See what God is doing in the world and how we can be part of it
- Serve in practical ways wherever is most helpful

PREPARATION

We recognize that participating in a trip like this can feel intimidating, however we are committed to help equip you for this experience.
